Author Visit

On Thursday, KS2 were very lucky to have local author Joffre White visit for the day. The day started with a Reading Motivator Show in the hall with all of the KS2 classes, where Mr White generated lots of enthusiasm about reading, his books - Frog and Aura Boy, and the books written by some of his author friends, including Cressida Cowell and Claire Barker (who visited us in December). He then delivered a creative writing workshop to Landacre class using some pictures and prompts to spark ideas for writing. After lunch, Mr White spent time with Beacon, Puffin and Dunkery where he was asked some excellent questions about being an author and his writing processes as part of Author in the Hot Seat sessions. Before leaving the site, Mr White sold and signed some of his books/bookmarks for the children. The visit was thoroughly enjoyed by KS2 and created quite a buzz of excitement throughout the day.
